Professor Linda Moy holds a joint appointment at the New York University (NYU) School of Medicine and at the NYU Center for Advanced Imaging Innovation and Research. Her career as a clinician and researcher focuses on diagnostic oncologic imaging, with an emphasis on the detection of breast cancer. She is the Deputy Editor of Breast Imaging for Radiology and Deputy Editor of Breast Imaging for Journal of Magnetic Resonance Imaging.

Her area of expertise is magnetic breast imaging (MRI) of the breast and multi-parametric imaging to detect breast cancer. Her research team has been awarded major research grants from the National Institute of Health and Department of Defense. She has authored or co-authored more than 130 original research articles, reviews and editorial articles. She is the editor of two textbooks on breast MRI. She is a reviewer on several NIH Study Sections that focus on Medical Imaging and Translational Imaging.

She is the Chair of the Radiological Society of North America's Scientific Program Committee on Breast Imaging. She is the chair of the American College of Radiology (ACR) Joint Committee on Breast Imaging for the Appropriateness Criteria and chair of the ACR Practice Parameters and Technical Standards. In addition, she holds leadership positions in the International Society for Magnetic Resonance, American Roentgen Ray Society and the Society of Breast Imaging.
