

Professor Takehiko Gokan graduated from Showa University School of Medicine in 1980 and started his career as Radiologist at Showa University School of Medicine in 1980. He became assistant professor of Radiology at Showa University in 1985. After one year staff radiologist at National Ookura Hospital, he became associate professor of Radiology at Showa University in 1986. He worked as clinical fellow at Radiology Department of Rochester University Hospital, NW, USA (1991-1993). He is currently Professor and Chairman of Radiology at Showa University Faculty of Medicine; a position he has held since 2005.

He published more than 500 articles including approximately 100 original articles in English. He had been awarded many International Congress Awards including Cum Laude Award at RSNA 1996, Certificate of Merit at ARRS 1997, and Poster Award at ESUR 2008 as the 1st author.

He is also now serving as Vice President of Japanese Society of Abdominal Radiology (JSAR), fellow of Asian Society of Abdominal Radiology (ASAR), and fellow of Society of Abdominal Radiology (SCR).
